CELLO-PIANO PIECE BASED ON CHRISTMAS CAROL "WHO IS THIS, SO WEAK AND HELPLESS" IN G MINOR

Theme and variation format.

## Possibilities:

- 1. Play the original. Cello plays the melody, piano plays the rest of the voices.
- Gradually take some of the familiar elements: Play melody as is, but change the harmonies underneath based on the unmodified melody notes (example of chromatic bass line)
- 3. Cello and piano duet. Cello could play a different melody, piano could play original melody with familiar harmonization
- 4. Cello and piano duet. Cello could play a different melody, piano could play original melody but using the unfamiliar harmonization
- 5. Cello and piano duet. Cello could play the original melody, piano could play a variation using the unfamiliar harmonization
- 6. Cello and piano duet. Cello and piano both play variation melodies, based on unfamiliar harmonization, but at least one of the instruments keeps the counting exactly as the original for a source of familiarity
- 7. At the end it could return to the familiar harmony, this time, reverse the roles: the piano cold play the melody and the cello could play another line, bass, tenor, alto, from the original arrangement.
